Qualifications include one of the following:

- An Associate's, Bachelor's or advance degree in a field related to early childhood education with experience in teaching preschool children.

JOB SUMMARY:

The Teacher is responsible for understanding, planning and implementing developmentally appropriate activities for pre-school age children. Develop weekly lesson plans and send to supervisor. Oversee and guide all individuals participating in the classroom. Maintain on-going assessments/screenings for each child. Plan and implement individualized activities for each child according to their MDT/IFSP/IEP. Communicate with parents on a regular basis. Complete required educational home visits and Parent/Teacher conferences for each child. Attend and participate in children's MDT and IEP/IFSP meetings. Enter documentation for each child and manage child data and reports through the online assessment system. Frequent kneeling, stooping, bending and lifting up to 50 pounds. Maintain confidentiality of program participants and follow Program and Agency standards and policies.

WAGE & BENEFITS:

The wage range is \$13.17 to \$15.82 per hour depending on education level. Benefits include health, life, dental and vision insurance. Paid holidays, vacation and sick leave, EAP, 401K Retirement.
